# TAKE SACRT TO THE SOPHIA IN MIDTOWN SACRAMENTO!

The Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) is a clean, safe and convenient way to travel to a performance. Because parking is limited at The Sophia, we strongly encourage theatre attendees to take advantage of the region's terrific public transportation system.

# TRAVELING TO THE SOPHIA

- For your convenience, SacRT has 52 light rail stations and 22 park-and-ride lots in a 43-mile service area and three bus routes (30, 38, 67 and 68) that serve within one block of the new Sofia Tsakopoulos Center for the Arts.
- To take light rail to downtown Sacramento, SacRT recommends parking at one of our 22 light rail stations (click here to access the light rail system map).
- To take bus routes 30, 38, 67 or 68.

# **SOPHIA STATIONS AND STOPS (Closest to The Sophia at Capitol Avenue)**

On weekdays, light rail trains operate every 15 minutes during peak commute times and 30 minutes all other times including weekends. To view a light rail system map, click here or call our Customer Service and Sales Center at 916-321-BUSS (2877) for trip planning assistance.

### Gold Line from Sunrise/Folsom

 Take light rail to the 29th Street Station, walk two blocks to 27th Street, turn right and walk five blocks to Capitol Avenue. View Gold Line Schedule

# Blue Line from south Sacramento/Cosumnes River College

- Take light rail to the 16th Street Station cross the platform and transfer to a Gold Line train traveling east toward Sunrise/Folsom. View Blue Line Schedule
- Exit at the 29th Street Station, walk two blocks to 27th Street, turn right and walk five blocks to Capitol Avenue. View Gold Line Schedule

# Blue Line from north Sacramento/Watt/I-80

- Take light rail to the 16th Street Station stay on the same side of the platform and transfer to a Gold Line train traveling east toward Sunrise/Folsom. View Blue Line Schedule
- Exit at the 29th Street Station, walk two blocks to 27th Street, turn right and walk five blocks to Capitol Avenue. View Gold Line Schedule

#### Green Line from 7th & Richards Boulevard

- Take light rail to the 13th Street Station stay on the same side of the platform and transfer to a Gold Line train traveling east toward Sunrise/Folsom. View Green Line Schedule
- Exit at the 29th Street Station, walk two blocks to 27th Street, turn right and walk five blocks to Capitol Avenue. View Gold Line Schedule

# **BUS ROUTE TRIP PLANNING TO THE SOPHIA**

**Route 30:** Travels to/from the CSUS Transit Center along J Street, L Street to/from the Sacramento Valley Station. Route 30 operates every 15 minutes during peak commute times and 30 minutes all other times including weekends. Depending on the direction of travel, riders should exit the bus at 28th and J streets, or 29th and L streets and walk a couple of blocks to The Sophia. View Bus Route 30 schedule and map

**Route 38:** Travels to/from the University/65th Street Transit Center along Broadway, Stockton Boulevard, Q Street, P Street, 30th Street, and downtown Sacramento. Route 38 operates every 60 minutes. Depending on the direction of travel, riders should exit the bus at 29th and P streets, or 29th and Q streets and walk a couple of blocks to The Sophia. View Bus Route 38 schedule and map

Routes 67/68: Travels to/from the Florin Towne Transit Center along Florin Road, Franklin Boulevard, MLK Boulevard, 29th Street, 30th Street, Business 80, and Challenge Way to/from the Arden Fair Mall Transit Center. Routes 67 and 68 operate every 15 minutes during peak commute times and 30 minutes all other times including weekends. Depending on the direction of travel, riders should exit the bus at 29th and N streets, or 30th and Capitol streets and walk a couple of blocks to The Sophia.
