

## 7. CUMULATIVE IMPACTS

The CEQA Guidelines (Section 15130 [a]) require that an EIR discuss the cumulative and long-term effects of the proposed project that adversely affect the environment. The CEQA Guidelines define cumulative impacts as two or more individual impacts, that, when considered together, create a considerable environmental impact, or that compound or increase other environmental impacts.

The proposed MOS-1 Project, in conjunction with proposed development in the vicinity of the project site and within the region, would contribute to cumulative environmental impacts. This cumulative development is assumed to be within the anticipated buildout planning horizon of the City of Sacramento General Plan, the Township 9 Plan, the Railyards Specific Plan, and the Richards Boulevard Redevelopment Plan.

The cumulative effects of the Proposed Project are identified and discussed within Sections 5.1 through 5.4 in Chapter 5, and no significant cumulative impacts were identified for the Proposed Project.
