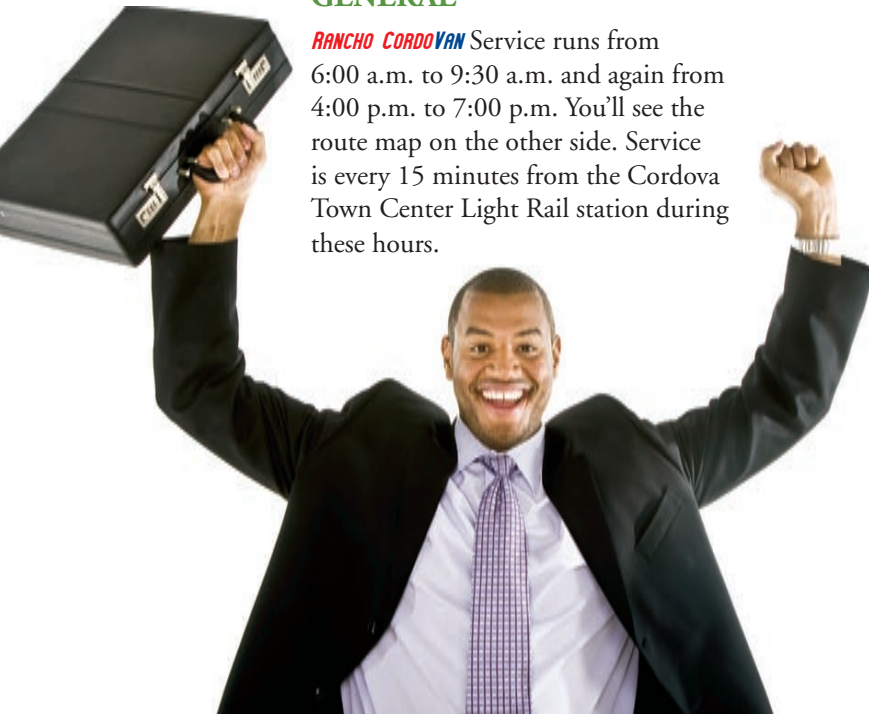

Welcome Aboard! You're one of Rancho Cordova's *PEOPLE ON THE GO*, smart people who recognize how easy, convenient and safe public transit can be. This brochure will help you ride in comfort.



## GENERAL

**RANCHO CORDOVA** Service runs from 6:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and again from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. You'll see the route map on the other side. Service is every 15 minutes from the Cordova Town Center Light Rail station during these hours.



**RANCHO CORDOVA** operates Monday through Friday. The service does not operate on the following seven holidays: New Year's Day, ML King Jr. Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Remember, we are also affected by weather and heavy traffic and we may occasionally experience unavoidable delays.

All **RANCHO CORDOVA** vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts and securements and drivers are trained to assist passengers with disabilities. If, due to disabilities, you are unable to get to a bus stop or cannot ride the regular routes, please call Paratransit service at (916) 557-4685 or 557-4686 TDD or go online at <http://www.sacrt.com/documents/ADAdocs/ParatransitGuide.pdf>

You must go through an eligibility process to qualify for this specialized service.



## FARES:

There are three ways to ride the **RANCHO CORDOVA**:

1. Show your valid Regional Transit transfer or daily/monthly pass
2. Pay 50¢ for basic fare
3. Pay 25¢ for senior/disabled,\* student\*\* fare

Please have exact change, the driver cannot make change.

Children under 12 ride free.

*\* Seniors (age 62 or older) or individuals with disabilities, and Medicare cardholders. Proof of identity (ID) is required upon boarding. Acceptable ID would include: a Regional Transit Senior or Disabled photo ID card, a Senior or Disabled photo ID card issued by another transit agency, a driver's license, a passport, or ID card issued by any governmental entity containing a photo of the cardholder (and also showing verification of age - for Seniors only). Attendants of persons with disabilities may ride for discount fare if the person has a Regional Transit Disabled photo ID card with Attendant eligibility notation.*

**\*\*Students must have a valid school ID.**

## SCHEDULE:

The **RANCHO CORDOVA** runs from 6:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and again from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Service is every 15 minutes from the Cordova Town Center Light Rail station.

**RANCHO CORDOVA** buses are scheduled to run every 15 minutes, leaving the Light Rail station close to the quarter hour. The route map shows where the bus stops are located. Always plan to arrive at your stop a few minutes before the bus arrives. If you miss your bus, another one will arrive within 15 minutes, during regular hours of operation.

The service does not operate on the following seven holidays: New Year's Day, ML King Jr. Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

**RANCHO CORDOVA** bus stop signs look like this so they're easy to spot. Bus stops are in specific locations where it is easy for the bus to stop and safe for you to board or exit. For your safety, do not try to stop the bus anywhere but at a designated bus stop.

## **Please:**

- Be courteous to your driver and other passengers
- No smoking, open food, drink, chewing gum, etc. on the buses
- If you want to listen to music, please use ear pieces so you don't disturb the other passengers
- Fold baby strollers and hold small children so they are safe and don't interfere with other passengers
- Give preferred seating to elderly, pregnant passengers and to people with disabilities
- Have your fare ready when you board
- Refrain from using profanity
- No solicitation
