Effective September 1, 2009, Central City/Shuttle fares have been discontinued and transfers will no longer be issued. **Bus:** Passengers are required to pay a Basic or Discount single fare for each trip or may purchase a daily pass valid for unlimited rides on that day. **Light Rail:** Single ride tickets are good for two hours from time of validation on light rail only. Daily and monthly passes are valid for unlimited rides on buses and light rail for the date(s) or month shown.

Agency agreements are subject to change.
