
Shop Small Business Saturday on November 30

The weekend following the Thanksgiving holiday is typically the busiest for retailers and a great way to support the "Mom and Pop" businesses in the Sacramento region by shopping Small Business Saturday on November 30.

SacRT will make it even easier by providing free rides all day on bus and light rail trains system-wide, and special SmaRT Ride shuttle service along a dedicated shopping route in the downtown/midtown communities between 9:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. with service every 15 to 20 minutes. Some of the popular shuttle stops include the Midtown Farmers Market, R Street, Ice Blocks, the Downtown Sacramento Ice Rink, and a variety of shops and restaurants. Park once, stay late and take the SmaRT Ride shuttle to and from Macy's Theatre of Lights in Old Sacramento Waterfront. RydeFreeRT Isn't Just for Trips to School

Youth in grades TK through 12 can take advantage of their valid student ID with RydeFreeRT sticker or RydeFreeRT card during the holiday break. Use it to ride SacRT buses and light rail trains to the movies, malls, museums, concerts, parks, ice skating, a visit with family or friends, or just about anywhere you want to go!

At the start of the school year, students automatically received a RydeFreeRT sticker with their valid student ID. If a school did not supply a student ID, students in grades TK through 6 can visit a local library to get a SacRT RydeFreeRT card with sticker. Stickers are also available for youth in grades 7 through 12 with a valid student ID card at local libraries and at SacRT's Customer Service and Sales Center located at 1225 R Street (adjacent to the 13th Street Station).

The Theatre of Lights is an electrifying and family-friendly, free holiday tradition. Discover the sounds of the fires, floods and revelry that befell the historic district in the 1850s as 150-year-old building facades light up with color on K Street between Front and 2nd streets. The highlight of the 20-minute production is a live dramatization of "Twas the Night Before Christmas," on the balconies above K Street, complete with a special appearance by Jack Frost.

Performances run Wednesday, November 27 through Tuesday, December 24. Visit GoDowntownSac.com/TheatreofLights for details.



SacRT Seeking Comments on Title VI Service Change Equity Analysis

SacRT is currently seeking comments on an equity analysis of potential service changes for April 2020. The report assesses any potential impacts on minority and low-income populations resulting from the proposed service changes, in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The analysis has been divided into two separate reports. The first addresses a proposed intercity bus service from Davis to the UC Davis Medical Center in Sacramento. The second addresses miscellaneous service changes prepared as a follow-up to SacRT's major service changes that were implemented on September 8, 2019. Both reports are available at sacrt.com.

All comments received before Tuesday, November 12 will be presented to the SacRT Board of Directors on Monday, November 18, along with revisions to the draft plan.

Bus Routes 38 and 82 Re-Routed Effective October 27

To better streamline the routes, changes affecting bus routes 38 and 82 were made on October 27. Route 38 detours off of J Street through East Sacramento. The route now travels on 29th or 30th streets, depending on the direction of travel, and now serves the UC Davis Medical Center via T Street. Route 30 still serves J Street in East Sacramento. Route 82 no longer stops at Whitney and Walnut in the Arden-Arcade area. There are two new stops; one at Mission and Whitney and one at Mission and Engle to better serve local residents.
