Blue Line Service Disruption

The Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) is scheduled to replace cables over the American River Bridge on Sunday, November 6. 2022 from 6 a.m. to noon. Due to the work required, electricity must be shut off in the vicinity temporarily disrupting SacRT light rail service from the Cathedral Square (10th & K) light rail station to the Marconi/Arcade light rail station. Special shuttle buses will transport passengers between 11th & K, 12th & J, Alkali Flat/La Valencia, Globe, Arden/Del Paso, Royal Oaks and Swanston stations.
