SCOPE

SacRT on the Move is the Short Range Transit Plan for the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT). This plan will make recommendations looking forward over the next five years.

ANALYZE
BASELINES

In September 2019, SacRT made major changes to the bus network with the SacRT Forward project. Every bus route had changes, and many shifted to a more frequent service seven days a week. In March 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic changed travel patterns every where. With the new bus network implementation, we will examine the data to see what is working and what is not, in addition to impacts from the pandemic.

ESTABLISH
VALUES

We will use the data and have conversations with stakeholders and the community to establish where we go from here. This plan will help guide the system on how to recover from coronavirus impacts. We want to hear from you.

We will share a draft Short Range Transit Plan with planned projects and potential service improvements with stakeholders and the public to educate and gain feedback on system recovery.
