# 13th & 16th Street Light Rail Station Improvement Project

### Fact Sheet


The Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT), Capitol Area Development Authority (CADA) and the City of Sacramento have partnered to improve the 13th & 16th Street light rail stations.

This project will renovate and enhance pedestrian and passenger connectivity to the 13th Street and 16th Street light rail stations, which are within the R Street Corridor redevelopment area. The total project cost is estimated at \$1,883,000. RT, CADA and the city of Sacramento have received a grant for \$1,693,000 from the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) Community Development Grants program. The grant is administered by the California Transportation Commission (CTC) and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). Of the \$190,000 local funds, \$90,000 will come from CADA tax increment revenues, and \$100,000 is being contributed by RT from Measure A funds.

RT will implement the light rail portion of the project, estimated to cost \$988,000. RT has hired Callander Associates, Inc. Landscape Architects, in association with Zeiger Engineers, Inc. (electrical) and Wallace Kuhl & Associates, Inc. (geotechnical), for the final design phase.


#### 13th Street Station Improvements



#### 13th Street Station:

- Mini-high shelters on ramps
- · Cosmetic improvements to existing shelter
- Additional pole lights
- New seating
- Miscellaneous plant replacements
- Miscellaneous tree and shrub pruning
- Repainting

#### 16th Street Station Improvements



#### 16th Street Station:

- · New mini-high ramp and removal of existing vertical lift
- Mini-high shelters on ramps
- Replace existing shelter canopy
- Additional pole lights
- New seating
- Removal of walls to increase sitting/standing pavement area on south side
- Planting screen on garage face (if funding permits)
- Miscellaneous plant replacements
- Miscellaneous tree and shrub pruning
- Repainting



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Both stations will also receive sidewalk improvements and directional signage within a 1-block radius, as well as other improvements to be constructed by the City of Sacramento.
