Blue Line to Cosumnes River College

Join the Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) as the blue carpet is rolled out to celebrate the historic opening of the new Blue Line to Cosumnes River College (CRC) light rail extension on Monday, August 24, 2015.

The new 4.3-mile Blue Line to CRC extension – opening ahead of schedule and under budget – will extend light rail from the current terminus at Meadowview Road to Cosumnes River College in south Sacramento, and features four new stations (Morrison Creek, Franklin, Center Parkway and Cosumnes River College); over 2,700 park-and-ride spaces; two pedestrian bridges connecting neighborhoods to light rail; and a bus/light rail transit center at CRC.

RT Announces Early Opening of Blue Line to CRC

RT has announced the opening date of the new Blue Line to Cosumnes River College (CRC) light rail extension. Mike Wiley, General Manager/CEO, announced on July 27 that the new line will open ahead of schedule and under budget on Monday, August 24, 2015.

The Blue Line to CRC will open earlier than the original September 2015 date to coincide with the start of the fall semester for Cosumnes River College and the Los Rios Community College District campuses.

The Blue Line to CRC will feature four new stations (Morrison Creek, Franklin, Center Parkway and Cosumnes River College). The Morrison Creek light rail station will open in 2017 when future development occurs in the area.

To commemorate the opening, RT has planned two public celebrations. On Sunday, August 23, RT will host a pre-opening community celebration at Cosumnes River College (east entrance at Bruceville Road) from noon to 5 p.m.

On Monday, August 24, RT will host the official grand opening ceremony at Cosumnes River College (east entrance at Bruceville Road) from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. to welcome the arrival of the celebratory train.

September 2015 Service Changes

Effective Sunday, September 6, 2015, RT will implement service changes that will restructure bus routes, and adjust bus schedules that connect with light rail (Blue Line and Gold Line) associated with the opening of the new Blue Line to Cosumnes River College (CRC) light rail extension.

Back to School with RT

Beat the rush and get your RT Student photo ID card before the school year begins!

RT Student photo ID cards can be obtained at the RT Customer Service and Sales Center for only \$2 through August. Students (age 5 to 18) must show proof of current school enrollment, or be accompanied by a parent or guardian to receive an RT Student photo ID card.

The Customer Service and Sales Center is located at 1225 R Street at the 13th Street light rail station.

By purchasing your Student photo ID card in advance, you can ride RT at the Discount rate. Monthly and semi-monthly Student stickers (fare) can be purchased at retail outlets throughout the Sacramento region (stickers must be affixed to a valid RT Student photo ID card).
