

# Amtrak/Folsom Light Rail Corridor Project


## Sacramento Valley Station Fact Sheet

### The Project

Regional Transit's light rail extension to Rancho Cordova and Folsom is designed to improve public transit service within a 23-mile corridor following Highway 50 between the Amtrak Station in Downtown Sacramento and the city of Folsom. The \$261 million Amtrak/Folsom Corridor Project consisted of four areas of improvements that added 10.7 miles of additional track, 10 stations, enhanced signaling and 14 new light rail vehicles. In December 2006, RT extended light rail to the Sacramento Valley Station near the Sacramento Amtrak Station. The Amtrak/Folsom Corridor Project was expected to add approximately 6,000 daily passengers. With all four areas of improvement now open, ridership projections have far exceeded expectations.
