# February 2019 FY 2019 - Key Performance Report

#### **Management Notes:**

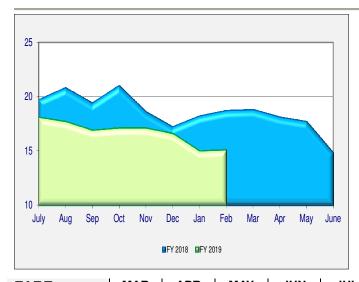
- The information in this report is based on the revised FY 2019 Operating Budget, adopted by the Board on February 25, 2019.
- RT's farebox recovery ratio in the month of February was 15.1 percent, and year-to date it is 16.7 percent. It has
  decreased by 3.6 percent compared to February 2018 and decreased by 2.5 percent year-to-date. In relation to
  the District's established goal for FY 2019, the RT's farebox recovery ratio is 0.3 percent below the established
  year-to-date goal. For the month of February, Fare Revenue was \$1.9 million and below seasonally adjusted
  budget by \$7 thousand. Compared to last year, Fare Revenue is \$1,351 thousand or 7.3 percent below last yearto-date total.
- Systemwide ridership for the month of February compared to the same period last year decreased by 3.0 percent, rail ridership increased 3.2 percent and combined bus ridership decreased 9.0 percent. Year-to-date, systemwide ridership compared to the same period last year decreased 3.1 percent, rail ridership decreased 2.5 percent and combined bus ridership decreased 3.7 percent. In relation to the District's established year-to-date ridership goals for FY 2019, systemwide ridership was 3.6 percent above the established goal, rail ridership was 5.9 percent above the goal, and combined bus ridership was 1.3 percent above the goal.
- In February 2019, total operating cost was \$13.8 million including \$6.5 million for bus, \$0.8 million for CBS, \$5.6 million for rail and \$0.9 million for Paratransit service.
- Year-to-date, RT's cost per passenger for bus service was under the District's goal at \$8.55, and cost per passenger for rail service was also under the District's goal at \$6.62.
- Year-to-date, RT's other cost factors (cost per hour, cost per mile) for bus and rail are under the District's budgeted levels. CBS cost per mile and cost per hour are exceeding the budget level due to delay in implementation of next phase of Microtransit service.
- Year-to-date, RT's passengers per revenue hour is above the District's goal by 5.7 percent for rail, by 1.1 percent for bus and by 45.8 percent for CBS.
- RT monitors the overall performance of the fleet to evaluate potential failure trends. In the month of February, combined bus service was reported at 13,037 miles between service calls, and rail service was reported at 7,768 miles between service calls.
- Year-to-date, RT's on-time performance for bus service is at 76.0 percent, which is 9.0 percent below the District's goal. On-time departures for rail service are at 95.1 percent below the goal of 97.0 percent. Completed trips for bus are 0.06% above the goal, for CBS is 0.44 percent above the District's goal, and for rail is 0.26 percent below the goal.
- The District's security statistics from RT's Police Services indicate a passenger inspection rate of 21.1 percent for the month of February 2019 compared to 20.7 percent in February of 2018.

#### **Operating Budget**

Net results for the month of February 2019 indicate a \$150 thousand positive variance to the District's FY 2019 Revised Operating Budget. In FY 2019, operating costs were under budget by \$871 thousand and revenues were below budget by \$721 thousand.

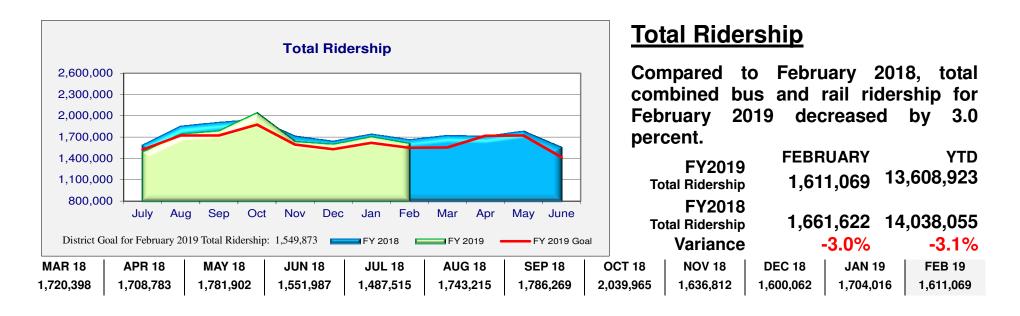


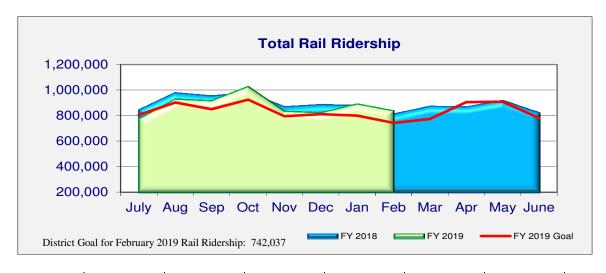
#### **Fare Recovery Ratio**

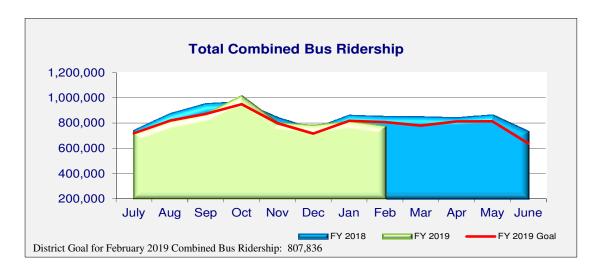


#### **Light Rail Ridership**

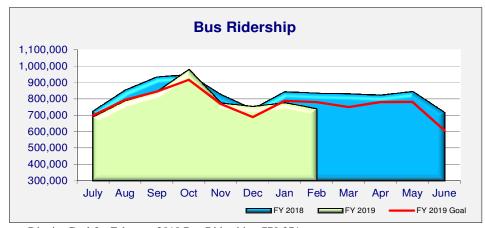

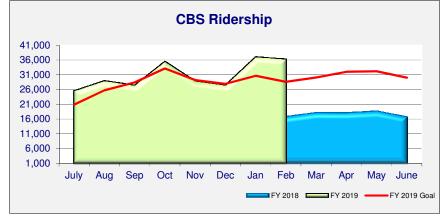

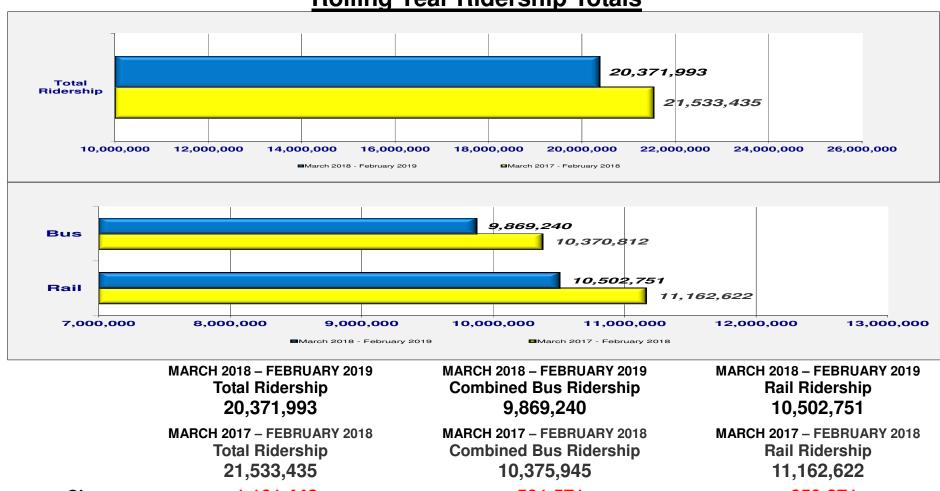


District Goal for February 2019 Bus Ridership: 779,271
