September 2020 FY 2021 - Key Performance Report

Management Notes:

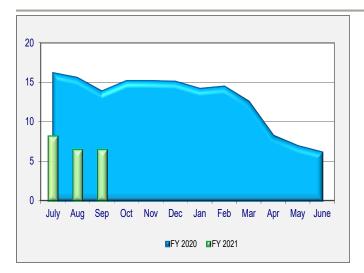
- The information in this report is based on the FY 2021 Operating Budget, adopted by the Board on June 8, 2020.
- September 2020 performance was greatly impacted by COVID-19 pandemic.
- Due to COVID-19 pandemic, systemwide ridership for the month of September compared to the same period last year decreased by 63.8 percent, rail ridership decreased 65.4 percent and combined bus ridership decreased 62.2 percent. Year-to-date, systemwide ridership compared to the same period last year decreased 61.5 percent, rail ridership decreased 63.4 percent and combined bus ridership decreased 59.2 percent. In relation to the District's established year-to-date ridership goals for FY 2020, systemwide ridership was 14.3 percent below the established goal, rail ridership was 18.1 percent below the goal, and combined bus ridership was 10.1 percent below the goal.
- RT's farebox recovery ratio in the month of September was 6.5 percent and year-to date it is 6.9 percent. It has
 decreased by 7.4 percent compared to September 2019 and decreased by 8.3 percent year-to-date. In relation to
 the District's established goal for FY 2021, the RT's farebox recovery ratio is 0.1 percent below the established
 year-to-date goal. For the month of September, Fare Revenue was \$1,015 thousand and below seasonally
 adjusted budget by \$165 thousand or 14.0%. Compared to last year, Fare Revenue is \$3,180 thousand or 50.2
 percent below last year-to-date total.
- In September 2020, total operating cost was \$16.25 million including \$7.19 million for bus, \$0.36 million for CBS fixed service, \$0.68 million for SmaRT Ride service, \$1.33 million for SacRT GO service, \$6.16 million for rail, \$0.53 million for Elk Grove e-tran service.
- Year-to-date, RT's cost per passenger for bus service was at \$26.10, and cost per passenger for rail service was at \$14.92. Light Rail cost per passenger is 24.5 percent over budget, and bus cost per passenger is 1.7 percent over budget.
- Year-to-date, RT's passengers per revenue hour is below the District's goal by 12.8 percent for rail, by 10.3 percent for Bus and for CBS 2.1 percent above budget.
- RT monitors the overall performance of the fleet to evaluate potential failure trends. In the month of September, combined bus service was reported at 14,677 miles between service calls, and rail service was reported at 9,667 miles between service calls.
- Year-to-date, RT's on-time performance for bus service is at 84.2 percent, which is 0.8 percent below the District's goal. On-time departures for rail service are at 97.8 percent above the goal of 97.0 percent. Completed trips for bus are on target, for CBS is 0.51 percent above the District's goal, and for rail is 0.09 percent below the goal.
- The District's security statistics from RT's Police Services indicate a passenger inspection rate of 25.5 percent for the month of September 2020 compared to 18.03 percent in September of 2019.

Operating Budget

Net results for FY 2021 year-to-date indicate a \$3,149 thousand positive variance to the District's FY 2021 Operating Budget. As of end of September 2020, year-to-date operating costs were under budget by \$2,542 thousand and revenues were above budget by \$607 thousand.

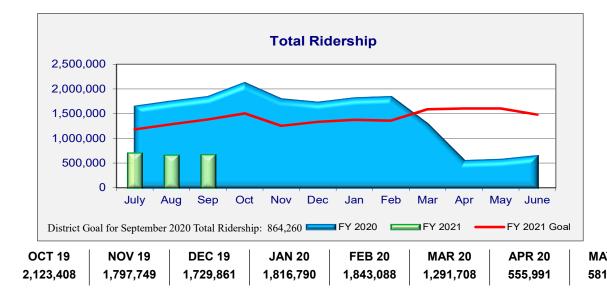


Fare Recovery Ratio

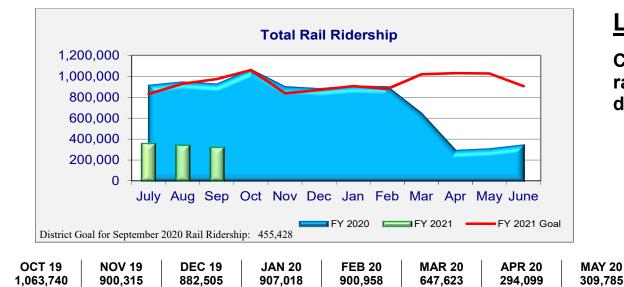

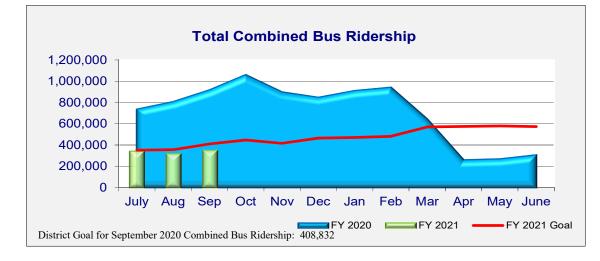

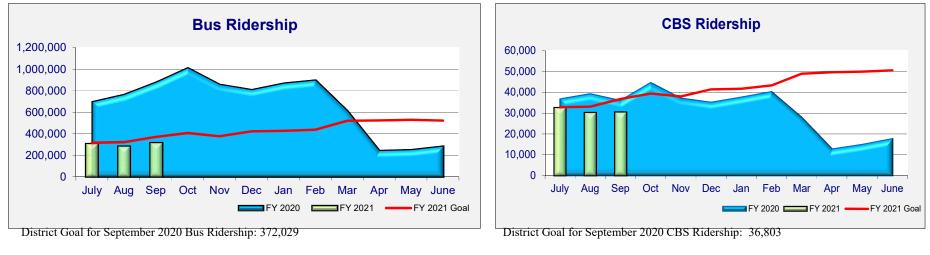

Combined Bus Ridership

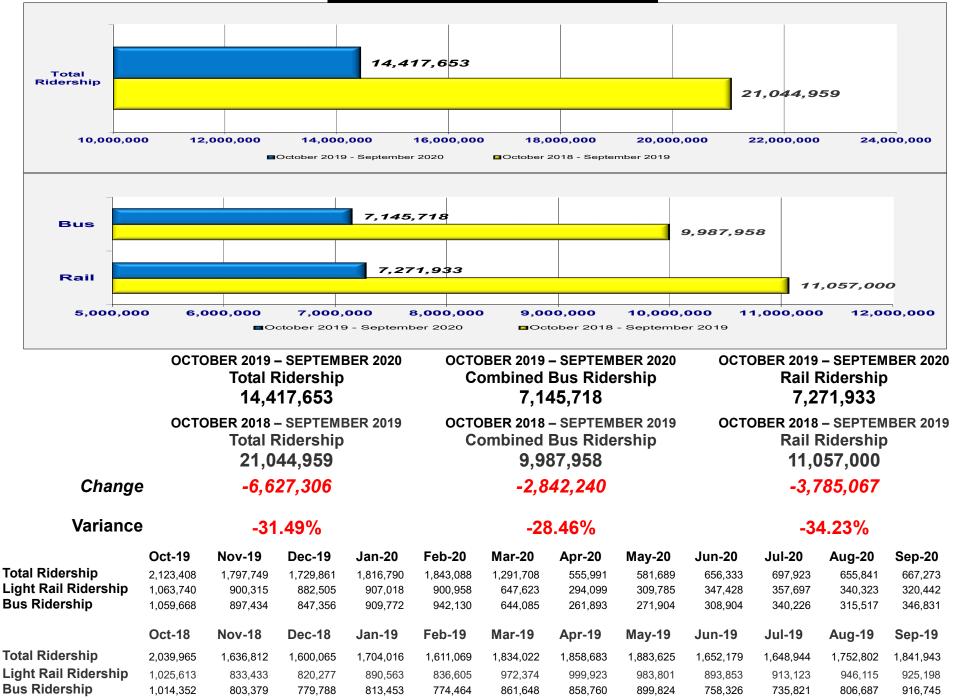

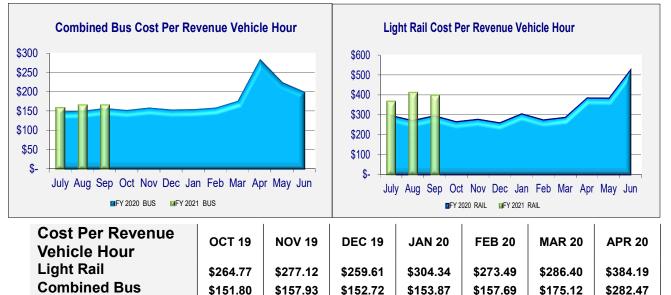
