### March 2018 FY 2018 - Key Performance Report

### **Management Notes:**

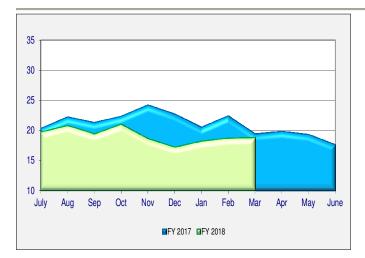
- The information in this report is based on the FY 2018 Operating Budget, Amendment 2, adopted by the Board on March 22, 2018.
- RT's farebox recovery ratio in the month of March was 18.8 percent, and year-to date it is 19.2 percent. It has decreased by 0.6 percent compared to March 2017 and decreased by 2.5 percent year-to-date. In relation to the District's established goal for FY 2018, the RT's farebox recovery ratio is 0.8 percent below the established year-to-date goal. For the month of March, Fare Revenue was \$2.27 million and below seasonally adjusted budget by \$249 thousand. Compared to last year, Fare Revenue is \$2.75 million or 11.7 percent below last year-to-date total. Fare Revenue is trending below last year due to RT transitioning to Connect card and other electronic media, which changed the way RT recognizes the Fare Revenue. As of March 31, RT has accumulated approximately \$518 thousand in deferred Fare revenue.
- Systemwide ridership for the month of March compared to the same period last year decreased by 17.2 percent, rail ridership decreased 18.8 percent and combined bus ridership decreased 15.5 percent. Year-to-date, systemwide ridership compared to the same period last year decreased 6.8 percent, rail ridership decreased 7.4 percent and combined bus ridership decreased 6.2 percent. In relation to the District's established year-to-date ridership goals for FY 2018, systemwide ridership was 1.5 percent below the established goal, rail ridership was 2.4 percent below the goal, and combined bus ridership was 0.6 percent below the goal.
- In March 2018, total operating cost was \$13.13 million including \$6.41 million for bus, \$0.35 million for CBS, \$5.31 million for rail and \$1.06 million for Paratransit service.
- Year-to-date, RT's cost per passenger for bus service was under the District's goal at \$7.74, and cost per passenger for rail service was also under the District's goal at \$6.05.
- Year-to-date, RT's other cost factors (cost per hour, cost per mile) for bus, CBS and rail are under the District's budgeted levels.
- Year-to-date, RT's passengers per revenue hour is below the District's goal by 2.0 percent for rail, below by 1.8 percent for bus and above the goal by 1.5 percent for CBS.
- RT monitors the overall performance of the fleet to evaluate potential failure trends. In the month of March, combined bus service was reported at 15,435 miles between service calls, and rail service was reported at 8,649 miles between service calls.
- Year-to-date, RT's on-time performance for bus service is at 76.7 percent, which is 8.3 percent below the District's goal. On-time departures for rail service are at 98.2 percent above the goal of 97.0 percent. Completed trips for CBS are 0.36 percent above the District's goal, for bus is meeting the goal, and for rail is 0.25 percent below the goal.
- The District's security statistics from RT's Police Services indicate a passenger inspection rate of 23.54 percent for the month of March 2018 compared to 21.28 percent in March of 2017.

## **Operating Budget**

Net results for the month of March 2018 indicate a \$351 thousand positive variance to the District's FY 2018 Operating Budget. In March, operating costs were under budget by \$311 thousand and revenues were above budget by \$40 thousand.

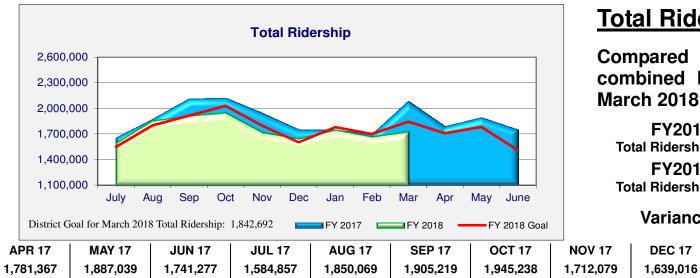


### Fare Recovery Ratio

Compared to March 2017, the fare recovery ratio for March 2018 decreased by 0.6 percent.

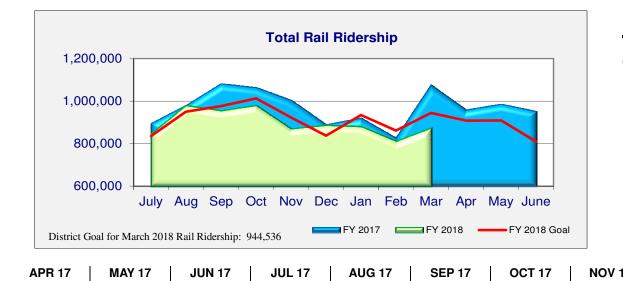

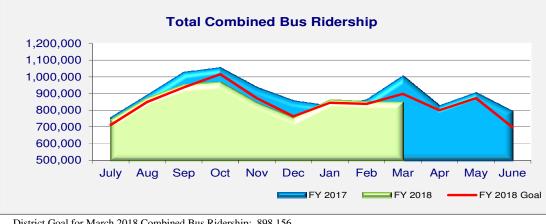

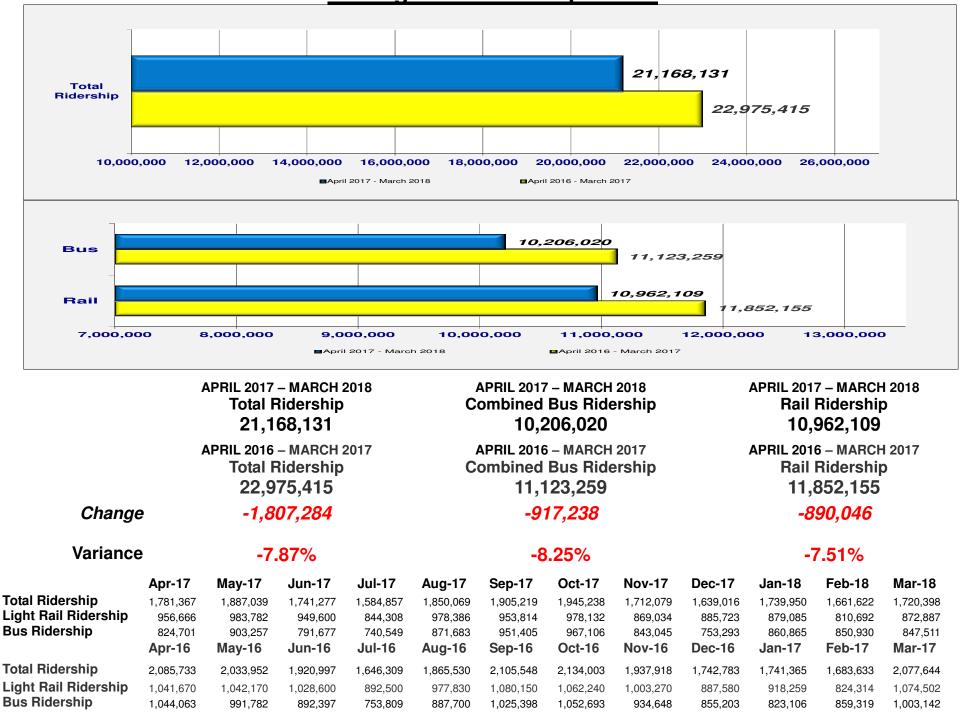
