September 2019 **FY 2020 - Key Performance Report**

Management Notes:

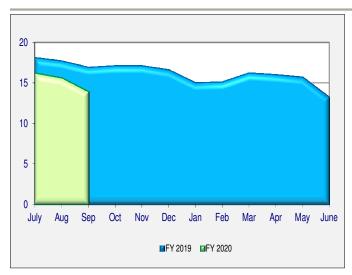
- The information in this report is based on the FY 2020 Operating Budget, adopted by the Board on June 10, 2019.
- RT's farebox recovery ratio in the month of September was 13.9 percent, and year-to date it is 15.2 percent. It has decreased by 3.0 percent compared to September 2018 and decreased by 2.3 percent year-to-date. In relation to the District's established goal for FY 2020, the RT's farebox recovery ratio is 1.2 percent below the established year-to-date goal. For the month of September, Fare Revenue was \$1.9 million and below seasonally adjusted budget by \$603 thousand. Compared to last year, Fare Revenue is \$276 thousand or 4.2 percent below last year-to-date total. In September 2019, SacRT had four free ride days to celebrate SacForward implementation.
- Systemwide ridership for the month of September compared to the same period last year increased by 3.1 percent, rail ridership increased 1.1 percent and combined bus ridership increased 5.3 percent. Year-to-date, systemwide ridership compared to the same period last year increased 4.5 percent, rail ridership increased 6.5 percent and combined bus ridership increased 2.4 percent. In relation to the District's established year-to-date ridership goals for FY 2020, systemwide ridership was 0.3 percent below the established goal, rail ridership was 1.7 percent above the goal, and combined bus ridership was 2.6 percent below the goal.
- In September 2019, total operating cost was \$15.52 million including \$6.86 million for bus, \$0.81 million for CBS, \$6.30 million for rail, \$0.97 million for Paratransit service, and \$0.58 million for Elk Grove e-tran service.
- Year-to-date, RT's cost per passenger for bus service was under the District's goal at \$9.24, and cost per passenger for rail service was also under the District's goal at \$6.79.
- Year-to-date, RT's other cost factors (cost per hour, cost per mile) for CBS and rail are under the District's budgeted levels. Bus cost per hour is above the District's goal.
- Year-to-date, RT's passengers per revenue hour is below the District's goal by 1.1 percent for rail and above the District's goal by 20.7 percent for CBS and 0.4 percent for bus.
- RT monitors the overall performance of the fleet to evaluate potential failure trends. In the month of September, combined bus service was reported at 14,085 miles between service calls, and rail service was reported at 6,321 miles between service calls.
- Year-to-date, RT's on-time performance for bus service is at 77.3 percent, which is 7.7 percent below the District's goal. On-time departures for rail service are at 95.5 percent below the goal of 97.0 percent. Completed trips for bus are 0.13% below the goal, for CBS is 0.52 percent above the District's goal, and for rail is 0.46 percent below the goal.
- The District's security statistics from RT's Police Services indicate a passenger inspection rate of 18.03 percent for the month of September 2019 compared to 23.51 percent in September of 2018.

Operating Budget

Net results for FY 2020 year-to-date indicate a \$1,002 thousand positive variance to the District's FY 2020 Operating Budget. As of end of September 2019, year-to-date operating costs were under budget by \$1,734 thousand and revenues were below budget by \$732 thousand.

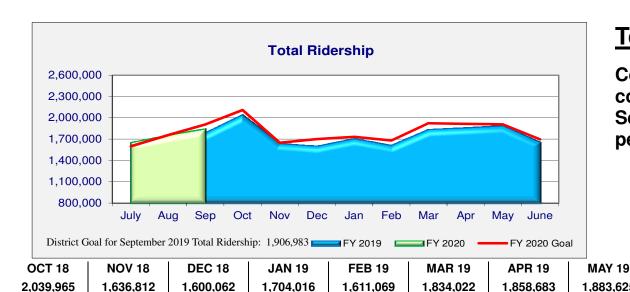


Fare Recovery Ratio

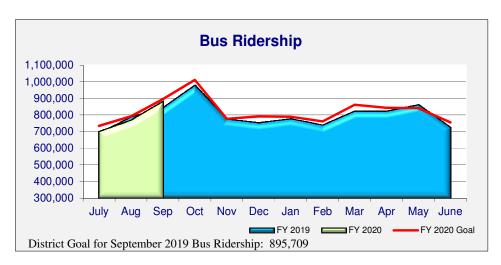

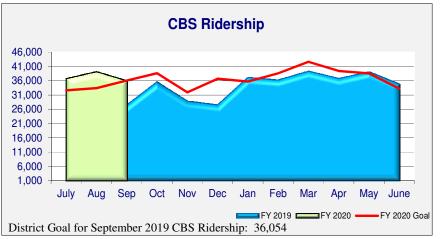


Combined Bus Ridership

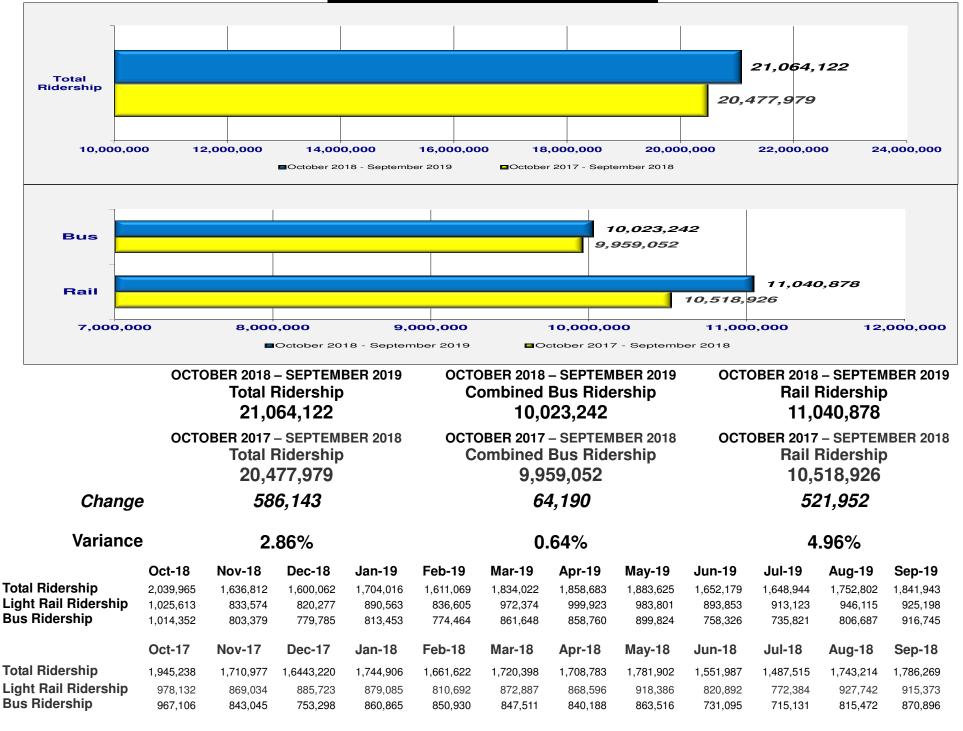

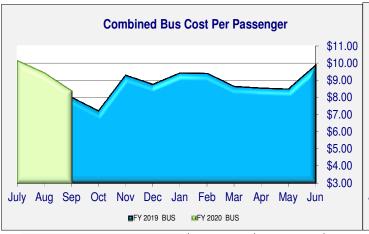

Rolling Year Ridership Totals



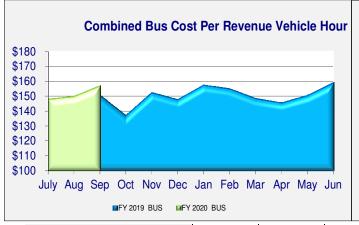


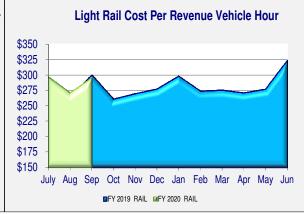
